

Dear Guest,

We are looking forward to welcoming you for your stay at 'Wighill Manor Lodges'.

On arrival, please park up and stay in your vehicle. Please call 07891 686516 (or 07989 744989) and we will come to you.

The plastic key fob is used to 'activate' the electrics in your lodge. To 'activate' the electrics, simply insert the fob into the slot within the main light switch which is located on the wall adjacent to the entrance doorway. When the key fob is removed from the switch it will turn off the TV, electric fire and main lighting - simply re-insert the fob to activate these items. A safe is located in the floor of the master bedroom wardrobe and the key is located on the previously mentioned key fob.

A 'Fire Action' notice is displayed above the key fob light switch and details the actions which should be taken in the event of a fire. A fire blanket is located on the wall in the kitchen area and a fire extinguisher is located in the kitchen under-sink cupboard. Torches are provided in each master bedroom, located in the bedside drawer, and in the kitchen located in the under-sink cupboard. Please familiarise yourself with these actions and items.

The electric fire is remote controlled and the remote control is located on top of the fire. To switch the unit on simply press the '|' button. This will activate the light effect of the fire. If you press the same button again, it will now activate the fan heater. The speed of this heater can be increased by pressing the same button again.

Waste bins are located by the gateway that you passed through on your way to your lodge. As you drive out from your lodge you will find them near the gateway. Please do not leave any rubbish outside your lodge as we have very inquisitive wildlife!

The hot-tub is ready for your use and all the instructions for its use and safety precautions are detailed in the lodge information folder. Please familiarise yourself with these instructions prior to using the Hot-Tub.

Hot-Tub Cover Opening & Closing: A laminated information leaflet regarding Hot-Tub cover opening and closing procedures can be found on the coffee table. Please familiarise yourself with the actions to open and close the lid - Incorrect actions will lead to damage of the lid and its securing straps. ***If you are in any doubt about operating the Hot-Tub please contact us.***

During your stay we are required to conduct chemical dosing level checks on the Hot-Tub. We will not disturb you, but you may see us on the decking carrying out these checks.

We politely ask that if you intend to use the Hot-Tub later in the evening you respect the comfort of our other guests and maintain noise levels to a respectful level.

The information folder in your lodge should answer most queries you have but please do not hesitate to contact us if you require assistance.

Please note that we do not permit visitors.

On your day of departure it would be greatly appreciated if you would strip all bedding & place rubbish in the provided refuse bins.

Please return the lodge key to the black postbox on the wall at the entrance to the house back yard (by Well). Please note, Check-Out is by 10am.

We hope you enjoy your stay at Wighill Manor Lodges.
